Sanitarian:

September activity report received. Reviewed reports. Copies of reports placed on file.
County is working with Lenape to stop students from vaping on school property. There are a lot of chemicals involved in vaping and we don't know what it will do health wise.
Denise was asked if she had received a call from a doctors office asking for information on who to contact regarding a hoarding situation. Patient was being sent home and there was a concern about their situation. Secretary provided County number to the concerned party with instructions to call her back if they needed any farther assistance. Call would most likely be handled by Adult Protective Services and Denise would not be notified. Denise Webb confirmed that if they are owners of the property there is nothing that can be done by her office since it's not a public health hazard.

Animal Control Officer:

September report received. Reviewed report and placed on file.
Discussed Animal Trust Fund - funds are from licensing animals. It is used for purchasing licensing software, animal tags, conducting the census and animal related items like rabies syringes. Since it is used for animal related matters might it be used for animal related hospital bills. Since there can be only a certain amount of money in trust, money is moved to general funds. Maybe paying for animal hospital bills might not be thought of as being paid by tax payers but by licensed animals. We have set \$2000 aside for neuter/spay program. Fund can be used to pay Animal Control. Request a report from Dana Mooney about fund.
