
Electronics Recycling (E-Waste)

New Jersey's *Electronic Waste Management Act* prohibits consumers from disposing of the following "Covered Electronic Devices (CEDs)":

- Desktop or Personal computers
- Computer monitors
- Portable computers (laptops, tablets)
- Desktop printers
- Desktop fax machines
- Televisions





The **SCMUA** serves as a collection site for Covered Electronic Devices for residents, schools, government entities and small businesses.

SCMUA Collection Events:

At the Spring and Fall Collection Events, CEDs and Non-CEDs are accepted for recycling at no charge. Non-CEDs include keyboards, mice, speakers, audio equipment, wires and scanners. **Not** accepted during the events: Motor vehicle electronic devices and appliances (microwave, air conditioner, dehumidifier, air purifier).

SCMUA Drop-off Program:

CEDs are accepted at the Residents Convenience Area during normal business hours at no charge. Non-CEDs may also be dropped off for a fee of \$0.13/lb.

Retail and Manufacturer Recycling:

Staples and other retail stores and manufacturers offer a variety of options to donate or recycle electronics. See the links below for more information.
