Mr. Gavan stated he reviewed the public notice sent for this hearing and he spoke to the applicant's attorney before the meeting regarding the notice. Chairwoman Maio stated there is an issue with the public notice and the applicant needs to re-notice. This hearing will be scheduled for the December 8, 2025 meeting.

PRESENTATION - REVIEW AND RECOMMENDATIONS - LVRHS Back-Lit LED Exterior Sign

Geoffrey Laurie, representing Lenape Valley Regional High School came forward and stated they are looking to install a backlit sign on the school's main exterior wall. Copies of the proposed sign and location were previously provided to the Board members for their review. The exterior wall is currently a bare brick wall by the auxiliary gym. The sign will display the school's name and will be lit at night. Chairwoman Maio noted this is a presentation and is for informational purposes only and for any recommendations the Board would like to make. It is for the Board's review and comment and is not an issue for the Board's approval. Mr. Laurie said the sign will commemorate the school's achievement of being named a "Blue Ribbon Schools Lighthouse of Excellence." The Board was in favor of the new sign and had no recommendations. Mr. Laurie thanked the Board. Mr. Gavan explained that this is a school board and they have to come before the Board and give you their plan for comments only of the Board. The Board can give input, but they do not have to do the Board's recommendations. The Board has no authority to require changes to the plan.

Mr. Gavan informed the Board that the notice for the ADG Amity Road LLC hearing stated variance relief for impervious coverage and critical slope disturbance and any other variance that may be deemed necessary. The notice did not include the “d” variance needed, which is an important variance and must be stated. A “d” variance cannot be included with “any other variances;” it must be identified in the notice. The applicant must re-notice for the “d” variance.
